Adverse Weather Protocol

Parents/Carers should note that **we will always make every attempt to keep the school open as usual.** However, the school may be closed, or timing adjusted if:

- Conditions onsite are dangerous
- Conditions are considered to be, or are anticipated to later become, too hazardous for travel
- Insufficient numbers of staff are able to come in to keep the school running safely including whether the kitchen can be opened

Parents/Carers should assume that the school is open for business as usual unless they hear from us. It is the responsibility of Parents/Carers to assess their own local conditions and decide as to whether it is safe for their child to travel.

During severe weather, pupils will be permitted to wear more suitable footwear such as sturdy walking/welly boots to and from school, but they must carry their school shoes in their bag to change into on arrival.

If the decision is taken to close the school, parents will be notified by:

Please note that due to the large volume of communication that is sent by local schools during severe weather there can be a delay to text messages and emails being received in your inbox. As such, it is important that you check the school website before setting out.
